



#### Introduction

We are very happy to announce the event 'Digitalization for Agriculture in Asia. Regional and Country Policies and Pathways'. The event is co-organised by the <u>Digital Agri Hub</u>, and the <u>Asian Development Bank Institute</u> (ADBI).
